#### Reason for change / expected benefits / business case:

The CSG Task Force (TF) on the Central Securities Depository Regulation (CSDR) is responsible for identifying the necessary T2S changes stemming from the CSDR requirements.

During the discussions on the CSDR requirements, it has been identified that CSDs must keep record of settlement instructions related to buy-ins, including, if applicable, the amount of cash compensation and cancellation of initial settlement instructions.

Reference to this requirement can be found in ESMA's Regulatory Technical Standards (RTS) on CSD Requirements under CSDR, Article 54, 'Transaction/Settlement Instruction (Flow) Records', point (x) and the corresponding 'Annex IV: Format of CSD records', Table 1, 'Transaction/settlement instruction (flow) records' (row 24), that defines the actual format to be followed for each record<sup>1</sup>.

In order for CSDs to identify buy-in transactions and be able to satisfy CSDR requirements related to buy-ins, T2S must be upgraded to identify, store, and report settlement information about buy-ins consistently across T2S messages: the usage of the ISO transaction type code 'BIYI' (BuyIn) is proposed to fulfil this purpose.

Currently, the transaction code 'BIYI' (BuyIn) is not available consistently across T2S messages:

- It is excluded from the valid ISO transaction codes list (SecuritiesTransactionType7Code) pertaining to 'sese.023' message (Securities Settlement Transaction Instruction) and the status advice 'sese.024' (Securities Settlement Transaction Status Advice), however it is available in the 'sese.025' (Securities Settlement Transaction Confirmation) based on ISO transaction codes list (SecuritiesTransactionType8Code).
- It is excluded from the valid ISO transaction codes list (SecuritiesTransactionType10Code) pertaining to 'sese.028' (Securities Settlement Transaction Allegement Notification) and semt.019 (Securities Settlement Transaction Allegement Report).
- It is excluded from the valid ISO transaction codes list (SecuritiesTransactionType9Code) pertaining to 'semt.018' message (Securities Transaction Pending Report), however it is available in 'semt.017' (Statement of Transactions) based on ISO transaction codes list (SecuritiesTransactionType8Code).

Consequently, T2S must be upgraded to identify, store, and report settlement information related to buy-in transactions in the above mentioned messages / corresponding ISO transaction codes list. This upgrade will require a change to ISO message to include the missing transaction code i.e. BIYI.

#### Description of Requested Change:

The ISO transaction code 'BIYI' (BuyIn) should be included as a valid value for the transaction type code <SciesTxTp> in the following T2S messages.

- Settlement Instruction (sese.023)
- Settlement Instruction Status Advice (sese.024)
- Statement of Pending Instructions (semt.018)
- Allegement notification (sese.028)
- Statement of Allegements (semt.019)

This upgrade will also require change to above mentioned ISO messages to include the missing transaction type code BIYI as a valid value.

The flat file version of statement of pending instructions should also report the transaction type code BIYI, following a like-for-like approach regarding the report content.

The ISO transaction code 'BIYI' (BuyIn) should be included as a valid value for the 'Securities Transaction Type' field on the following T2S U2A screens.

- Settlement Instruction - New Screen
- Settlement Instructions - Search/List Screen
- Settlement Instruction - Details Screen

A new system privilege "Use ISO transaction code BIYI (BuyIn)" should also be added in the list of privileges related to settlement instruction management.

The DMT (Pending Instruction) shall also allow to input the ISO transaction type code 'BIYI' (BuyIn).

**Outcome/Decisions:**

- \* CRG meeting on 6/7 July 2016: The CRG decided to put the Change Request on hold
- \* CRG meeting on 26 October 2016: The CRG agreed to keep the Change Request on hold and discuss it during the CRG meeting in December 2016 during the T2S future releases scoping exercise with a possible clearer view on CSDR implementation deadline.
- \* CRG meeting on 07 June 2017: The CRG recommended the Change Request for detailed assessment and asked the 4CB to check the feasibility to deliver it in T2S Release 3.0. The CRG was of the opinion that the Change Request should be classified as 'evolution/enhancement due to regulation'.
- \* Operational Mangers Group on 19 June 2017: During a written procedure from 9 to 19 June 2017, the Operations Managers Group did not identify any blocking operational impact of the Change Request.
- \* Advisory Group on Market Infrastructures for Securities and Collateral (AMI-SeCo) on 19 June 2017: Following a written procedure from 09 to 19 June 2017, the AMI-SeCo was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- \* CSD Steering Group on 20 June 2017: Following a written procedure from 09 to 20 June 2016, the CSD Steering Group was in favour of launching the detailed assessment on the Change Request.
- \* CRG meeting on 23 October 2017: The CRG put the Change Request on hold.
- \* OMG written procedure ended 15 November 2017: the OMG did not identify any blocking operational impact of the CR
- \* RMSG meeting on 14 December 2017: The RMSG asked the 4CB to initiate a re-assessment for the Change Request 607 with a view on including it in the scope of R3.0.
- \* CRG meeting on 15 December 2017: The CRG asked the 4CB to perform a re-assessment of the CR detailed assessment with a view to implement it in R3.0 with Change Request T2S-0612-SYS and without Change Requests T2S-0606-SYS and T2S-0609-SYS.

Summary of functional, development, infrastructure and migration impacts

**SDMG**

A new privilege "Use ISO Transaction Code BIYI (BuyIn)" must be added to the T2S database.  
The ISO transaction code BIYI must be configured in the T2S database.

**LCMM**

The relevant communications related to Settlement Instructions and Allegements must be aligned in order to allow the ISO trx code "BIYI".

A new Validation check needs to be defined to check that the User has the necessary privilege to instruct a Settlement Instruction using the "BIYI" ISO trx code.

The different values that can be stored for the attribute "ISO trx code" are not hardcoded and therefore LCMM can currently process and store this value without any update, however, the different inbound and communication modes specifications need be updated accordingly whenever the possible values are defined.

**Main cost drivers** (All will take place during implementation phase):

- Update of the instruction validation module with the new privilege to allow the processing and further reporting of the Buy-In ISO Transaction Code.
- Testing the inclusion of the new ISO code and its related privilege validation. It also considers regression testing to ensure a high-quality delivery in all ways.

Add new BR MVCPXXX to business rules table of UDFS chapter 3.3.8.4.2 for the message element securities transaction type.

**Main cost drivers** (All will take place during implementation phase):

- Performing regression testing to ensure a high-quality delivery
